Cookie Overview

A cookie is a small piece of data that is sent to Your browser or device by websites, mobile apps, and advertisements that You access or use. This data is stored on Your browser or device and helps websites and mobile apps remember things about You.

Category of Cookies

Analytics. We use these cookies to help us improve our services. For example, we can use these cookies to learn more about which features are the most popular with You. **Performance.** We use these cookies to collect information about how You interact with our Services and to help us improve them.

For example, we may use these cookies to determine if You have interacted with a certain page.

Preferences. We use these cookies to remember Your settings and preferences. For example, we may use these cookies to remember Your language preferences. **Promotional Activity.** We use these cookies to deliver advertisements, and to track the efficiency of our advertising campaigns, both on our Services and on other websites or mobile apps. **Security** We use these cookies to help identify and prevent security risks.

For example, we may use these cookies to prevent others from changing Your password without Your username and password.

Cloudimage's Use of Cookies

Similar with other Service providers, Cloudimage uses cookies to protect Your data and account, detecting the most popular features, counting visitors to a page, improving Your experience, keeping the Services up to date and secure, and just generally providing You with a better, improved, and satisfying experience. The cookies we use generally fall into one of the following categories.

Other Similar Technologies

We may also use other similar technologies on our Services, such as pixel tags and local storage. We use these technologies to do things like help us see what features are most popular, create a more personalized experience, etc. Pixel tags (also called clear GIFs, web beacons, or pixels) are small blocks of code installed in or on a webpage, mobile app, or advertisement. These tags can retrieve certain information about Your browser and device such as: operating system, browser type, device type and version, referring website, website visited, IP address, and other similar information. Local storage is an industry-standard technology that allows a website or mobile app to store and retrieve data on an individual's computer, mobile phone, or other device.

What Can You Do?

Your browser lets You choose whether to accept browser cookies and You may even be able to choose or limit the use of cookies and other similar technologies in mobile apps. But please remember these technologies are an important part of how the Services work, so removing or rejecting cookies could affect the quality of our Services.

Web browser opt-out

Most web browsers are set to accept cookies by default. If You do not want to allow cookies You have some options. Your browser may provide You with a set of tools to manage cookies. You can usually set Your browser to refuse some cookies or all cookies. You may also be able to remove cookies from Your browser. Your ability to manage cookies through a mobile browser, however, may be limited.

Mobile device opt-outs

Your mobile operating system may let You opt-out from having Your information collected or used for interest-based advertising on mobile devices. You should refer to the instructions provided by Your mobile device's manufacturer.
